While many groups in St. Petersburg that aid people experiencing homelessness have ceased or curtailed their activities, <u>Celebrate Outreach</u>, a coalition of St. Petersburg area faith groups, **continues to serve 250 meals each week to those living on the streets**, all while maintaining sound COVID-19 health practices. Celebrate Outreach and their coalition partners have changed their usual sit-down community meals to carry-out bagged meals.
